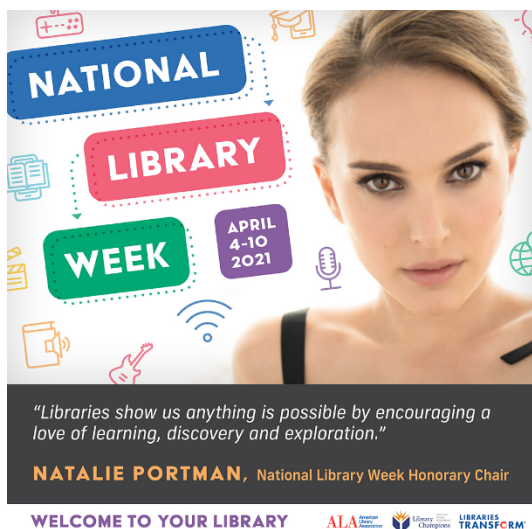


## In-Library Appointments Start April 5
